**A. Opening prayer. Commissioner Beck led the Court in the invocation.**

**B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Gist moved that the minutes of the October 16, 2006 meeting be approved, with the following amendment:**

**Item #2: addition of the phrase “effective when he takes office” instead of “effective as soon as the ballots are canvassed after the November 7, 2006 General Election.”**

**Commissioner Carroll seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.**

**D. Matters of new business to be presented to the Court for its consideration and action as appropriate. Items may not be taken in the order that they are listed.**

**Item #1: David Carroll, Precinct #4-approval to purchase vehicle for County. Commissioner Carroll told the Court that the Election Administration Office was in need of a vehicle with a lift gate, to transport the election equipment to the polling locations. He also stated that the truck could be used by all County Departments. Commissioner Carroll moved that the Court authorize the purchase, from the 2005/2006 Budget, the following vehicle:**

**Ford F350 box van, 12' by 8', with a lift gate**

**From Bostick Auto and Truck Sales for \$10,000.00**

**2000 model with 91,000 miles**

**Commissioner Gist seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.**

**Item #2: Proclamation declaring November, 2006 as Home Health Care Month in Texas. Commissioner Gist moved that the Court approve a Proclamation proclaiming November, 2006 as Home Health Care Month in Texas. Commissioner Beck seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #1)**
