**The Brown County Commissioners Court convened in a Special Session on June 2, 2008 at 9:00 A. M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Brown County Courthouse, 200 South Broadway Brownwood, Texas. Judge West called the meeting to order.**

**A. Opening prayer. Commissioner Gist led the Court in the invocation.**

**B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Adams moved that the minutes of the May 19, 2008 meeting be approved, as presented by County Clerk Margaret Wood. Commissioner Traweek seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.**

**D. Matter of new business to be presented to the Court for its consideration and action as appropriate. Items may not be taken in the order that they are listed.**

**Item #1: Bobby Grubbs – Employee changes. Commissioner Gist moved that the Court approve the following personnel change in the Sheriff's Office:**

**Commissioner Adams seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve.**

**Item #2: Larry Traweek, Precinct 4 - Discussion and approval of 35 mph speed limit CR 156. Commissioner Traweek moved that the Court approve a forty (40) mile per hour speed limit beginning at the intersection of CR #178 and CR #156 south to the first corner, in Precinct #4. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #2)**

**Item #3: Larry Traweek, Precinct 4 - Discussion and approval of 40 mph speed limit CR 175. Commissioner Traweek moved that the Court approve a forty (40) mile per hour speed limit beginning at the intersection of CR #175 and CR #178 North to Highway #67, in Precinct #4. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #3)**

**Item #4: Amy Hamrick-Approval of new employee.**

**Item #5: Ray West-Discussion and action for resolution regarding fireworks ban. Judge West moved that the Court adopt an order prohibiting the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Brown County. Restricted fireworks mean only those items classified under the Local Government Code as “skyrockets with stick” and “missiles with fins”. Commissioner Gist seconded the motion and the Court voted as follows:**

**Item #6: Richard Gist, Precinct 3 - Notice of communication line installation, CR 381. Commissioner Gist moved that a notice of installation of a communication line, made by Verizon Southwest, within the right-of-way of CR #381, in Precinct #3, be approved; subject to Brown County specifications. Commissioner Kelton seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #6)**

**Item #7: Approval of Tax Resale Deed-Ashley Stevens, Lots 88, 89 and 90, Oak Trails Addition, Brown County, Texas. Judge West moved that the Court approve a tax resale deed to Ashley Stevens, of property described as Lots 88, 89, and 90, Oak Trails Addition, Brown County, Texas. Commissioner Adams seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve. (Exhibit #7)**

**E. Reports. The June 2, 2008 Cash Position Statement was presented by County Treasurer Ann Krpoun, for filing. (Exhibit #8)**

**The June 2, 2008 Jail Population Report was presented, for filing, by Sheriff Grubbs. (Exhibit #9)**

**F. Consideration and approval of bills. Commissioner Kelton moved that the claims, as presented by County Auditor Nina Cox, be paid. Commissioner Traweck seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #10)**

**G. Recess. Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court recess until June 9, 2008 at 9:00 A.M. in the Commissioners Courtroom. Commissioner Traweck seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.**
