The Brown County Commissioners Court convened in a Regular Session on October 14, 2014 at 9:00 A.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Brown County Courthouse, 200 South Broadway Brownwood, Texas. Judge West called the meeting to order. Members of the Court present were:

- A. Opening prayer. Judge West led the Court in the invocation.**
- B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Kelton moved that the minutes of the October 6, 2014 meeting be approved, as presented by County Clerk Sharon Ferguson. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.**
- C. Recognition of visitors.**
- D. Matter of new business to be presented to the Court for its consideration and action as appropriate. Items may not be taken in the order that they are listed.**

Item #1: Joel Kelton, Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban. After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains lifted.

Item #2: Renee Howes-Consideration and possible approval of King's Point Cove, Unit 3. After discussion, with Renee Howes, consultant for DFC Texas Land, LLC, and Brown County Surveyor Don King, Commissioner Traweek moved that the Court approve the plat and restrictions, for King's Point Cove Unit 3 Subdivision, for filing. Item #3: Becky Caffey-Consideration and possible approval to replace steamer in jail kitchen. Becky Caffey, Brown County Jail Administrator, presented to the Court two quotes for a new steamer for the jail kitchen. One quote was from Roberts & Petty, Inc. and one from Angelo Commercial Restaurant Equipment. After discussion, Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court approve the quote from Angelo Commercial Restaurant Equipment. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion. After discussion, Commissioner Kelton rescinded his motion.

After discussion, Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court approve the quote, from Angelo Commercial Restaurant Equipment, for \$9,311.60, for a new steamer for the jail kitchen. This purchase is to be paid from the Equipment Budget. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. Included is Exhibit #4 detailing what has already been spent on repairing the old steamer.
