- A. Opening prayer. Rick Phelps led the Court in the invocation.**
- B. Reading and approval of minutes. None.**

Item #1: Joel Kelton, Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban. After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains lifted.

Commissioner Traweek seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.

Item #3: Jennifer Robison, County Auditor, Consideration and possible approval for payment of the County Attorney administrative employees' salaries from the general fund. After discussion, with Brown County Auditor Jennifer Robison and Brown County Attorney Shane Britton, Judge West moved that, until further action is taken by the Court, the County's General Fund assume responsibility to pay the two County Attorney administrative employees' supplement to their salary and that to the end that an Opinion is rendered by the Attorney General's Office, that any money that has been paid by the County's

General Fund be re-imbursed should the AG Opinion come back with a decision that it can be. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.

Item #4: Jennifer Robison, County Auditor-Consideration and possible approval to deem items that did not sell on GovDeals as surplus items and approve disposal by Office Furniture Specialist. After discussion, with Brown County Auditor Jennifer Robison, Commissioner Worley moved that the Court declare a list of county office equipment, that did not sell on GovDeals, as surplus items to be disposed of by Office Furniture Specialist. Commissioner Traweck seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. ([Exhibit #3](#))
