**B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Traweek moved that the minutes of the March 5, 2018 meeting be approved, as presented by County Clerk Sharon Ferguson. Commissioner Kelton seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.**

Commissioner Traweek moved that the Court approve an application, made by Brookesmith SUD, to install a buried water line within the right-of-way of County Road #152, in Precinct #4; subject to Brown County specifications for boring a road.
