1. Declare a Quorum and Call Meeting to Order

Judge Lilly declared a Quorum and called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Traweek led the Court in the invocation.

Commissioner Traweek moved that the minutes of the April 15, 2019 meeting be approved, as presented by County Clerk Sharon Ferguson. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the court voted 4-0 to approve. Judge Lilly abstained because he was not present at the meeting.

Commissioner Kelton moved that the claims, as presented by Assistant County Auditor Josie Contreras, be paid. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve.

B. Dr. Paul Lilly, County Judge-Consideration and possible approval of renewal of the contract with County Information Resources Agency (CIRA) for the Brown County website.
