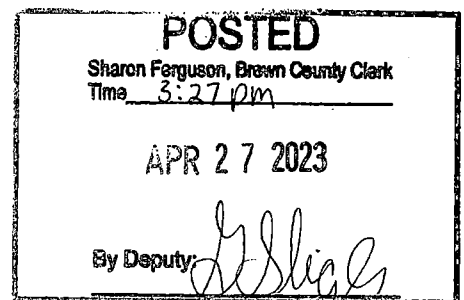


## SPECIAL MEETING TO PAY BILLS

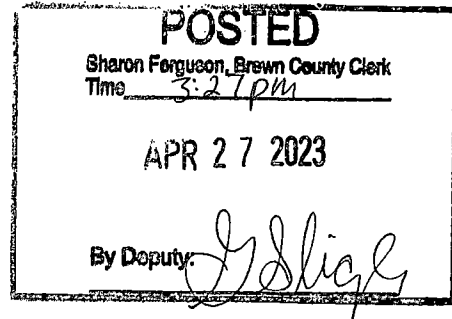
