- A. Opening prayer. Judge West led the Court in the invocation.
- B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Traweek moved that the minutes of the April 11, 2016 meeting be approved, as presented by County Clerk Sharon Ferguson. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the Court voted 3-0 to approve.
 - C. Recognition of visitors.
- D. Matter of new business to be presented to the Court for its consideration and action as appropriate. Items may not be taken in the order that they are listed.

Item #1: Joel Kelton, Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban. After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains lifted.

Item #2: Mike Strawn, TAC-Presentation regarding Risk Control Reimbursement Program. Mike Strawn, Risk Management Consultant representing TAC, presented a program concerning a competitive Risk Control Reimbursement Program offered by Texas Association of Counties. No action was taken. (Exhibit #1)

Item #3: Vance Hill, Capt. Sheriff's Office-Discussion of issues with the in car patrol videos and possible approval to replace the equipment. After discussion, with Sheriff's Chief Deputy Vance Hill, no action was taken.

Item #4: Vance Hill, Capt. Sheriff's Office-Acceptance of funds from the NRA Foundation. After discussion, with Sheriff's Chief Deputy Vance Hill, Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court accept the National Rifle Association grant funds, of \$2,801.88, presented to the Sheriff's Department. Commissioner Traweek moved that the Court accept the bid, from CMC Government Supply, for \$2,723.28, to purchase, for Law Enforcement, seven (7) Benilla Nova 20056 Pump Tactical Shotguns, and seven (7) side saddles all to be paid for with the total of the NRA grant funds and any balance due from the General Fund.
