


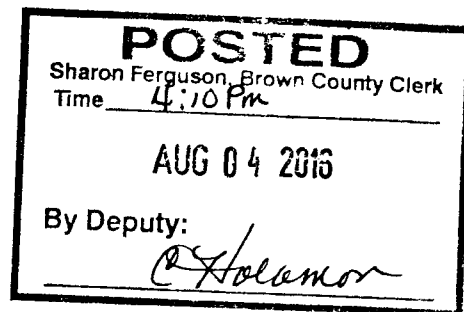

Item #1: Joel Kelton, Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban. After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains in effect.

Item #2: Kim Wilder, VALIC-Consideration and possible approval to offer employees the option to participate in Roth accounts in 457(b) b plans in addition to the current deferred compensation plan. After discussion, with Kim Wilder, with VALIC, Commissioner Worley moved that the Court authorize VALIC to offer County employees the option to participate in Roth accounts in 457(b) plans. Commissioner Kelton seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.

Item #3: Ronnie Lappe, Brown County Historical Commission-Discussion and possible approval for cleanup request of the Lewis Family Cemetery. No action.

Item #4: Jennifer Robison, County Auditor-Consideration and possible approval of First Southwest Arbitration Contract. Judge West moved that the Court approve the Agreement For Arbitrage Rebate Compliance Services Between Brown County, Texas and First Southwest Asset Management, LLC. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve. (Exhibit #1)

At 9:25 A.M. Judge West moved that the Court recess until 9:45 A.M. to consider Item #5: Budget Hearings. Commissioner Kelton seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.

F. Consideration and approval of bills. Commissioner Worley moved that the claims, as presented by County Auditor Jennifer Robison, be paid. Commissioner Traweek seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 approve. (Exhibit #4)

G. Approval of Treasurer's/Auditor's Report. The Total Of Funds Under The Care & Custody Of Brown County Treasurer And Auditor's Report For July, 2016 was approved after a motion by Judge West and a second by Commissioner Traweek. The Court voted 5-0 to approve. An Affidavit, with the Report attached, was signed and prepared for publication, according to Section 114.026 of the Texas Local Government Code. (Exhibit #5)
