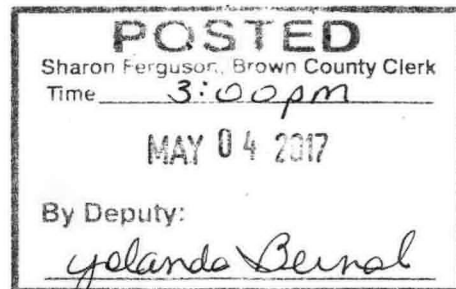

- A. Opening prayer. Rick Phelps led the Court in the invocation.**
- B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Worley moved that the minutes of the May 1, 2017 meeting be approved, as presented by County Clerk Sharon Ferguson. Commissioner Kelton seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.**

Item #1: Joel Kelton, Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban. After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains lifted.

Item #3: Vance Hill, Sheriff-Consideration and possible approval to declare vehicles and/or equipment as surplus. After discussion, with Sheriff Vance Hill, Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court declare 4 Charger patrol vehicles, with their attached equipment, as surplus, to be listed on the GovDeals online auction. Commissioner Worley moved that the Court authorize the Sheriff's Department to accept NRA grant money, for \$2,289.90, specific for buying shotguns for patrol officers. Commissioner Traweck seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.
