- A. Opening prayer. Rick Phelps led the Court in the invocation.
- B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Worley moved that the minutes of the August 7, 2017, August 8, 2017 and August 9, 2017 meetings be approved, as presented by County Clerk Sharon Ferguson. Commissioner Kelton seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.
 - C. Recognition of visitors.
- D. Matter of new business to be presented to the Court for its consideration and action as appropriate. Items may not be taken in the order that they are listed.

Item #1: Joel Kelton, Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban. After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains in effect.

Item #2: Rick Phelps-Formal invitation for Commissioners Court and department heads to 9/11 Ceremony. Rick Phelps formally invited the Commissioners Court and all County department heads to a 9/11 Ceremony, on behalf of the Victory Life Academy. The ceremony will be September 11, 2017 at 9:00 A.M. at Victory Life Church. The Court thanked him for the invitation.

Item #3: Vance Hill, Sheriff's Office-Consideration and possible approval to purchase security camera upgrades for jail holding and visitation. Sheriff Vance Hill presented, to the Court, a quote, for \$27,662.00, from Guardian Security Solutions, LC, for 22 security cameras to be used for upgrades to the jail holding and visitation areas at the Sheriff's Department. After discussion, Judge West moved that the Court approve the installation of camera upgrades, for the jail holding and visitation area, as submitted by the Sheriff Hill, on the condition that it is paid for by NCIC, and that NCIC follows up with the Grant that they have promised and that if that Grant is not forthcoming that the equipment be removed by the vendor. The NCIC Technology Enhancement is for \$25,000.00. The remaining balance, of \$2,662.00, will be paid from the Sheriff Department's Commissary Fund. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve. (Exhibit #1)

Item #4: Joel Kelton, Pct 2-Application to install private line, CR 411. Commissioner Kelton moved that an application, made by Brookesmith SUD to install a buried water line within the right-of-way of County Road #411, in Precinct #2, be approved; subject to Brown County specifications. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #2)

Item #5: Wayne Shaw, Pct 3-Consideration and possible approval of employee. Commissioner Shaw moved that the Court authorize him to hire Brett Chaput, for Precinct #3, effective August 7, 2017, on a part-time/full-time basis. Mr. Chaput will be paid \$12.00 per hour. Commissioner Traweek seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #3)
