- B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Kelton moved that the minutes of the February 12, 2018 meeting be approved, as presented by County Clerk Sharon Ferguson. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion and the Court voted 3-0 to approve.

Item #1: Joel Kelton, Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban. After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains in effect.

Item #2: Becky Caffey, Chief Deputy of Corrections-Consideration and approval of interlocal agreement to house inmates for McCulloch County. After discussion, with Sheriff Vance Hill, Commissioner Worley moved that the Court approve an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement For County Jail Functions between Brown County and McCulloch County. Commissioner Kelton seconded the motion and the Court voted 3-0 to approve. (Exhibit #1)

Item #3: Vance Hill, Sheriff-Consideration and possible approval for authorization to expend funds for jail repair. After discussion, with Sheriff Vance Hill, Commissioner Traweek moved that the Court authorize Sheriff Hill an expenditure, up to \$3,500.00, for repair of the shower stalls inside the inmate facilities at the jail.
