- A. Opening prayer. Rick Phelps led the Court in the invocation.
- B. Reading and approval of minutes. Commissioner Traweek moved that the minutes of the December 10, 2018, December 17, 2018, December 31, 2018, and January 7, 2019 meetings be approved, as presented by County Clerk Sharon Ferguson. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.

Item #1: Joel Kelton, Commissioner Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban. After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains lifted.

Item #2: Vance Hill, Sheriff-Consideration and possible approval of employee changes. After discussion, with Chief James Stroope, Commissioner Worley moved that the following personnel changes be approved in the Sheriff's Department:

Commissioner Traweek seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.

Item #3: Joel Kelton, Commissioner Pct 2-Consideration and possible approval of Easement on High Mesa Drive. Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court approve an application, made by Oncor Electric Delivery, for a 30 ft easement to be put on a property the County owns off of High Mesa Drive and being the line will go on property the County owns and not in the County road ROW, in Precinct #2; subject to Brown County specifications. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #3)

Item #4: Sharon Ferguson, County Clerk-Consideration and possible approval of surplus equipment to be sold on GovDeals or to order destroyed. After discussion, with County Clerk Sharon Ferguson, Commissioner Shaw moved that the Court authorize the County Clerk to list, for sale, an IBM printer, on the GovDeals online auction and to authorize the County Clerk to destroy three (3) Lexmark forms printers that have been found to have no value. Commissioner Traweek seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. (Exhibit #4)

Item #5: Jennifer Robinson, County Auditor-Consideration and possible approval of payment of old outstanding invoices. Commissioner Shaw moved that the Court authorize County Auditor Jennifer Robison to pay four (4) old 2009 invoices, for \$1,200.00, to Attorney Mark Bessent. Commissioner Worley seconded the motion and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.
