

The Salvation Army - Brownwood Service Center

The Salvation Army - Brownwood Service Center's primary purpose is to feed hungry people in Brown County.

Anyone in need of a meal is welcome to the center for hot meal three days week, or a sack lunch two days of the week.

We also operate a mobile emergency disaster canteen that provides meals to victims and first responders during times of disaster, like the Zephyr fires.

Our center is sometimes able to provide financial aid for utility disconnections; housing and rent; medical and prescription assistance; lodging; and transportation assistance to those in need.

In short, our work ensures basic necessities are met in order for individuals and families in our community.

The Need

We have recently had to reduce our hot meal service to 3 days a week (from 5), and provide sack lunches on 2 days, due to a budget shortfall.

While we are continuing to provide meals to nearly 100 people Monday through Friday, we don't want to have to reduce our services any further.

A recent break-in left our center with damaged and missing supplies.

We respectfully ask the Commissioner's Court's support in these areas:

- Adding the Salvation Army to its 2019-2020
 Budget in the amount of \$3500
- Consideration for surplus equipment
- · Connections to other resources
- Support from individual Commissioners
