

**SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL RESOLUTION
OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT
OF BROWN COUNTY, TEXAS**

REGARDING AUXILIARY FACILITIES FOR COURTROOMS

On the 7th day of July, 1997, the Commissioners Court of Brown County, Texas did pass a resolution regarding auxiliary facilities for the District Courtroom which provided for use of Adams Street Community Center and the Academy of Freedom on Howard Payne University Campus in Brownwood, Texas, to be used as auxiliary courtroom sites when needed.

On August 12th, 2002, the Commissioners Court of Brown County, Texas did pass a supplemental resolution regarding auxiliary facilities for the District Courtroom as set out in Volume 48, Page 233 of the official records of the County Clerk of Brown County, Texas.

Because of the COVID-19 Pandemic, currently affecting Brown County and the world, it is necessary for additional auxiliary facilities for the 35th Judicial District Court of Brown County, Texas, the Brown County Court at Law, and any other court of Brown County, Texas, as may be required. In order to comply with the guidelines of the Emergency Orders of the Supreme Court of Texas, the Court of Criminal Appeals of Texas, the Governor of Texas and the COVID-19 Operating Plan for the Brown County Judiciary, the Commissioners Court of Brown County, Texas does hereby resolve as follows:

The Local Administrative District Judge for Brown County, Texas is authorized to utilize as additional auxiliary facilities for courtroom use for any of the courts of this county that may require it, the following locations:

1. Any appropriate building on the Howard Payne University campus located in Brownwood, Texas;
2. The Brownwood Coliseum located in Brownwood, Texas;
3. The Lyric Theater located in Brownwood, Texas

The use of any auxiliary courtroom facilities will be done as mutually agreed between the necessary entities involved. No county monies will be obligated for these auxiliary facilities without the express written consent of the Commissioners Court of Brown County, Texas.
