

## RESOLUTION FOR BROWN COUNTY

## APPROVAL OF ADDING THE CITY OF BROWNWOOD TO THE FEMA APPROVED WEST CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS PLANNING AREA 6 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, natural hazards in the West Central Texas Region, Texas, historically have caused disasters with losses of life and property and natural resources damage; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) require communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS, FEMA requires the communities update Hazard Mitigation Action Plan every five years in order to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS, BROWN COUNTY, through the hazard mitigation planning process, has assessed the community's potential risks and hazards and is committed to planning for a sustainable community and reducing the long-term consequences of natural and man-caused hazards; and

WHEREAS, the WCTCOG HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN outlines a mitigation vision, goals and objectives; assesses risk from a range of hazards; and identifies risk reduction strategies and actions for hazards that threaten the community.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Brown County Commissioners affirms Brown County's commitment to the West Central Texas Council of Governments Planning Area 6 Hazard Mitigation Plan Update by allowing the City of Brownwood the option of being added to the existing FEMA approved West Central Texas Council of Governments Planning Area 6 Hazard Mitigation Plan Update.
