WORKSHOP SESSION PURPOSE

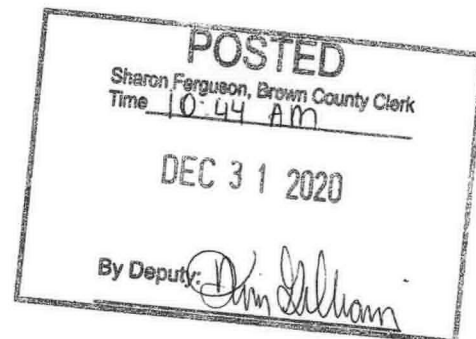
1. Discussion regarding the 2021 Infrastructure repairs and upgrades to the courthouse.
