



The Brown County users will access Odyssey via a secure Web interface. The Odyssey SaaS model eliminates the need for heavy upfront computer hardware costs, minimizes the need for internal IT staff dedicated to your CMS software and doesn't require a separate maintenance contract.

By removing the need for costly and complex computer hardware and related software, Odyssey will allow Brown County to focus your technology investments on judicial operations. Tasks that would otherwise require significant time, personnel, and planning (such as back up, data recovery, application updates and software maintenance) are performed by Tyler at no additional cost as part of our SaaS model. # **6.0 Proposal Assumptions**

The estimates above reflect an Odyssey Solution implementation over approximately 16 months to address the Case Management, Prosecutor and Jail Management needs of Brown County. This cost proposal includes the following assumptions:

- The software license costs reflect a Software-as-a-Service license model that allows Brown County to deploy the solution to approximately 80 users. More users can be added at an additional monthly per user cost.
- The cost proposal covers all functionality Tyler identified pertaining to State requirements, but otherwise assumes implementation of Odyssey out-of-the-box, and that vast majority of functionality would be established through configuration, instead of software modification.
- Brown County will make available the necessary subject matter experts (SMEs) during the project. These SMEs will assist in data validations, system assessments, report selection and design, and configuration processes.
- Client will provide Tyler Technologies with data from the source system(s) as SQL Server back-ups or ASCII files, delimited or fixed width.
- For converting images, the Client will produce an "index" file containing pertinent info on each document to be converted.
- Tyler will perform a standard conversion from the source system(s) to the Odyssey database using Tyler's existing IFL tool. This proposal assumes all data will be converted "as-is" with limited or zero data manipulation or cleanup. Data will not be split or merged.
- > Tyler will work closely with Client representatives and implementation staff to identify conversion rules (this step is typically known as data mapping).
- > Tyler will perform three data conversion pushes and one go-live data conversion push.
- Data Conversion and Data Review activities will be run as a Single Sprint/Workshop and all Offices will participate during this time frame.
- > Tyler will assist in Data Review Workshops, but the Client will be responsible for validating the accuracy of the converted data, based on reviewing data and reports during each conversion iteration.
- This proposal includes specific time for Tyler analysts and trainers to assist the Client with configuration of the system, which includes defining security, setting up code tables, and defining system behavior and business rules. This activity requires significant participation by the Client.
- > Tyler assumes the Client will be responsible for the completion and management of the configuration after the associated Sprint/Workshops conclude. Tyler consultants



- will be available for assistance, but the Client will be responsible for managing their configuration going forward.
- This proposal includes a limited amount of training time for a specific set of users just prior to go-live. Follow-up training is also included after go-live. Additional on-site training and assistance can be purchased at Tyler's then-current hourly rate.
- Fraining will be performed in a classroom setting using facilities and equipment provided by Client such that each participant can have hands-on access to a computer during training. Training will be conducted during business hours to a maximum of 15 participants per instructor.
- The Client will be responsible for the completion of forms after the Forms workshop/sprint concludes. Tyler consultants will be available for assistance, but the client will be responsible for the delivery and execution of this item.
- > Tyler assumes a single Go-Live event for all offices included in this proposal.
- This proposal includes a specific amount of time for on-site Go-Live assistance and follow-up training. Additional on-site training and assistance can be purchased at Tyler's then-current hourly rate.
- Client will reimburse Tyler for actual and reasonable travel expenses, at least the rates specified by the US General Services Administration.
