7. Consideration and approval of payment of any bills needed.

No action was taken.

The Total Of Funds Under The Care & Custody Of Brown County Treasurer And Auditor's Report for September 2021 was approved after a motion by Commissioner Kelton and a second by Commissioner Traweek. The Court voted 3-0 to approve. An Affidavit, with the Report attached, was signed and prepared for publication, according to Section 114.026 of the Texas Local Government Code. (Exhibit #3)

 - A. Joel Kelton, Commissioner Pct. 2-Consideration and possible approval of action regarding burn ban.

After discussion, no action was taken. The burn ban remains lifted.

B. Lisa Dick, Administrator-Brownwood/Brown County Health Department-Update on COVID 19 response and County health initiatives. (Pct. 2)

C. Angie Dees, Senior Citizens Program Director-Consideration and possible approval of adopting and signing a Resolution Authorizing County Grant Program Year 2022 for The Texas Feeding Texans Home Delivered Meals Grant Program.

After discussion, with Angie Dees, Director of the Senior Citizens Program, Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court adopt a Resolution certifying that the County has made a grant to Brownwood Senior Citizens-City of Brownwood, that will allow the County to apply for its share of a grant from the Texas Department of Agriculture to assist with financing a home delivered meal program that provides meals to home bound persons in the County who are elderly and/or have a disability. Commissioner Traweek seconded the motion and the Court voted 3-0 to approve. (Exhibit #4)

Commissioner Kelton informed that Court that some offices met with NetData and NetData will be back to visit with other offices on Thursday and that the Ambulance Oversight Committee will meet on Thursday.
