ORDER IPROHIBITING OR RESTRICTING CERTAIN FIREWORKS

IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF Brown COUNTY, TEXAS
WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions exist: Brown County; and
WHEREAS, on the 13 of June 2022, the Commissioners Court of Rown County has determined that the normal danger of fire in the unincorporated areas Brown County is greatly enhanced by the extremely dry conditions now existing;
NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of 3000 County adopts this Order [prohibiting OR restricting] the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporate areas of 3000 County.
A. A person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified a "skyrockets with sticks" under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2) (10-01-86 edition) of missiles with fins in any portion of the unincorporated areas of (2004). Count
B. [Describe specific restrictions, if applicable.]
C. This Order does not prohibit "permissible fireworks" as authorized occupations Code Section 2154.003(a).
D. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class of Misdemeanor.
E. This order expires on the date the Texas Forest Service determines drough conditions no longer exist in the county or July 4, 2022 [Insert date on or after July 4], whichever is earlier.
