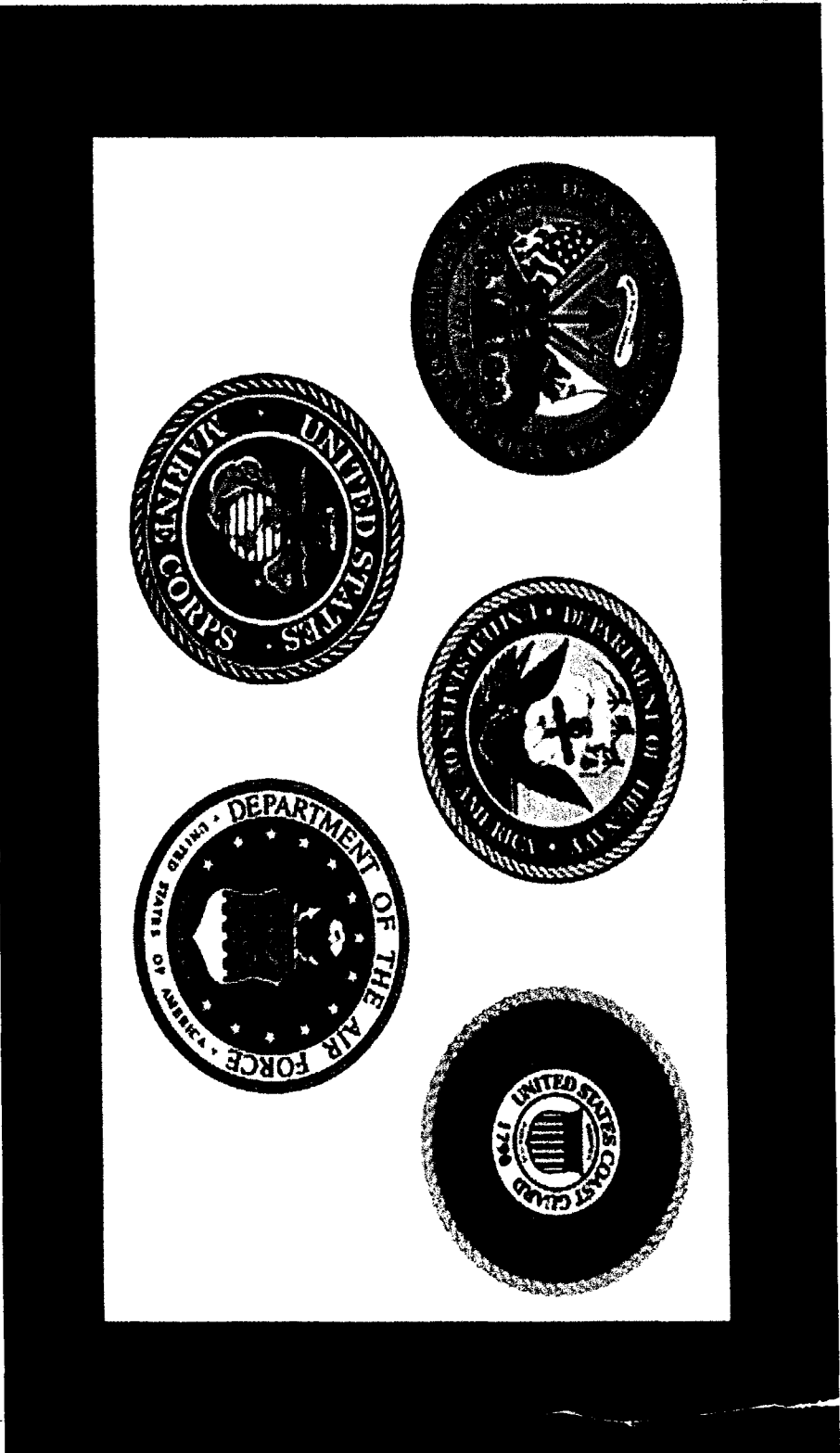

Brown County Veteran Population

- **2,914** total Veterans
- World War II-38
- Korean War-192
- Vietnam-1024
- Desert Storm-523
- Operations Enduring Freedom & Iraqi Freedom-594
- Cold War & other periods of service-543

Direct Economic Impact

\$18,993,000.00 in Federal Benefits recovered through Compensation & Pension to Service/Non-service Connected Veterans, their Widows, and other programs. This represents direct payments to the recipients. This is a \$1,167,000.00 increase.

- The Compensation & Pension expenditures include dollars for the following programs: veterans' compensation for service-connected disabilities; dependency and indemnity compensation for service-connected deaths; veterans' pension for non-service-connected disabilities; and burial and other benefits to veterans and their survivors.

Education Expenditures

The Veteran Service Office assists Disabled Veterans & their Dependents with education benefits resulting in \$899,000.00 to higher education institutions in Brown County

Expenditure data sources: USASpending.gov for Compensation & Pension (C&P) and Education and Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment (EVRE) Benefits; Veterans Benefits Administration Insurance Center for the Insurance costs; the VA Financial Management System (FMS) for Construction, Medical Research, General Operating Expenses, and certain C&P and Readjustment data; and the Allocation Resource Center (ARC) for Medical Care costs.

Veteran Administration Clinic

- **\$1,800,000.00 in total payroll.**
- **This results in an overall \$174,000.00 economic impact in direct sales & property tax recovery**
- **Provides \$13,761,000.00 in medical services in patient care, nursing home contracts, & home health care contracted services**

Veterans Administration Health Clinic

- **Provides services to 2341 Veterans, 1404 of which live outside Brown County Zip-Codes**
- **Out of County Veterans travel to the clinic at least twice annually spending an average of \$34.00-\$50.00* per visit in Brownwood**

• Does not account for the current inflation and gas hikes

Veteran Service Office

- **The Service Office provided services to 793 Brown County and area Veterans in 224 office days fielding 1826 phone calls**
- **Brown County Service Officers are Accredited at the National Level with the National Association County Veteran Service Officers , Texas Veteran Commission, Veterans of Foreign Wars, & Disabled American Veterans.**

Veteran Service Office

- **The Service Office is fully Accredited with The Veterans' Benefit Administration with full access to the Electronic Claim Processing Data Base. This allows real time claims monitoring to the Veteran**
- **The Veteran Service Officers attends 2-3 formal training conferences which maintains the National Accreditation and Electronic access in addition to Zoom training**

Veteran Service Office

- **The Service Office attends Brown County Disability meetings with several County and State Agencies within the County.**
- **The Service Office supports the Military Forces at Camp Bowie with Veterans and Dependent benefit briefings.**
