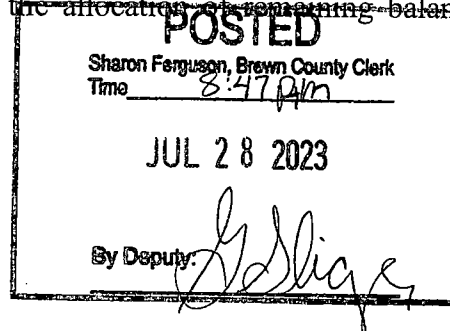




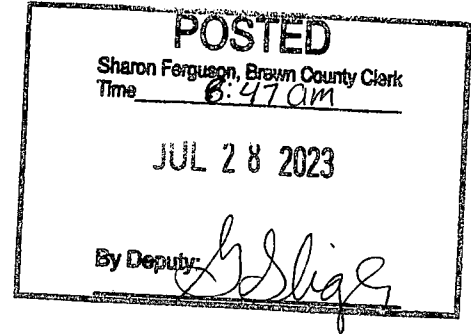

After discussion, Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court approve an expenditure of 2.3 million, of ARPA funds, for computer hardware and software infrastructure. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve.

After discussion, Commissioner Kelton moved that the Court approve an expenditure of \$50,000.00, of ARPA funds, for the purchase of a boat for the BCWID. Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the Court voted as follows:

The motion did not pass.

After discussion, Commissioner Kelton moved that the remaining balance of ARPA funds, after all expenditures, be allocated equally to each County Precinct. Commissioner Traweck seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve.

Commissioner Kelton informed the Court that Precinct #2 will be paving County Road #436.


X. ADJOURNMENT


