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2023 FCH Highlights

Childcare Conference was a multi-county event that provided training for people who work in the childcare industry. Our presenters were from the childcare licensing agency, local experts, and AgriLife FCH Agents. **29 childcare providers** or directors from 6 counties provide care for **881 children** enrolled in **12 childcare centers** or family day homes. A total of **174 clock hours** were provided to childcare professionals needing to meet state-mandated training requirements established by the state of Texas.

Food Handler's is a 2-hour program accredited by the Department of State Health Services, providing training for front-line food service workers on the basic principles of food safety.

Food Protection Management is a two-day certified food manager program that prepares food service workers to sit for the state Certified Food Manager exam.

Healthy County Wellness Program is a free program through BlueCross BlueShield that offers many different avenues to get and stay healthy.

Healthy School Recognized Campus - is a 3-way partnership which includes the school, parents, and Extension to focus on developing healthy lifestyles for a lifetime. Last year Wendy and I completed this program and won 2 state awards for it. This year Nick joined us. Three different programs were utilized to educate the students, parents and school staff.

Matter of Balance – is an 8-lesson class that is designed to reduce the fear of falling by setting goals for increasing activity levels, making small changes to reduce fall risks at home and exercise to increase strength and balance.

Walk Across Texas! is an 8-week physical activity challenge where teams walk 832 miles, the distance across Texas.

- 31 participants
- 6,964 we walked across Texas almost 8 times.
- If the 31 adult participants completing the program continue walking at the same level as during WAT! they have the potential to save a collective **\$199,699** in future health care costs by avoiding type 2 diabetes and by reducing work absences. The economic benefit of the Walk Across Texas! Adult program is a measure that uses WAT! program evaluation results, disease risk rates, health care costs, and worker productivity.
