I. DECLARE A QUORUM AND CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Judge Britton declared a Quorum and called the meeting to order.

An Affidavit, with the Report attached, was signed, and prepared for publication, according to Section 114.026 of the Texas Local Government Code. (Exhibit #3)

Courtney Parrot, Family and Community Health Agent, reported to the Court a 2023 Brown Healthy County summary. A Health and Wellness Committee (HWC) consisting of county employees and our Wellness consultant from the TAC was formed to promote and guide the county's health and wellness program. (Exhibit #4)

B. Community Wildfire Protection Plan-Presented by Jule Richmond and Sponsored by Commissioner Wayne Shaw Pct.3.

After discussion with Jule Richmond and Cy Tongate, Commissioner Worley moved that the Court approve a Proclamation for the development of a Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP). Commissioner Shaw seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve. (Exhibit #5)

Commissioner Worley moved that the Court approve an application made by Brookesmith SUD to install a buried water line within the right-of-way of the southside of Vick Drive, in Precinct #1; according to Brown County specifications for boring or cutting a road. Commissioner Traweek seconded the motion and the Court voted 5-0 to approve. (Exhibit #8)
