CONTINUATION OF DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Brown County, Texas on this the 13th day of May, 2024, determined that Brown County has been affected by recent severe storms and widespread flooding which caused extensive damage to public and private property, disruption of utility service, and endangerment of the health and safety of the residents of Brown County, and continues to be threatened by these severe weather conditions and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Brown County, Texas, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect life, as well as to protect or rehabilitate property, are necessary and hereby ordered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF BROWN COUNTY:

- I. That a local state of disaster was declared by the County Judge for Brown County, Texas on May 8, 2024 pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

- II. Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than 90 days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners' Court of Brown County, Texas.

- III. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly

with the County Clerk.

- IV. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the county/city Emergency Management Plan.
