After discussion with County Auditor Jennifer Robison, Commissioner Traweek moved that the Court approve to refinance two existing loans with Citizens National Bank pursuant to Section 271.005 of the Texas Local Government Code, that the obligations be payable from the Ad Valorem taxes, budgeted for payment for the obligations or any lawfully available funds, from the Brown County General Fund, Precinct #2 Fund and Precinct #4 Fund to pay the obligations in full at the end of the fiscal year as follows:

Commissioner Kelton seconded the motion, and the Court voted 4-0 to approve.
