The Total Of Funds Under The Care & Custody Of Brown County Treasurer And Auditor's Report For July 2025 was approved after a motion by Commissioner Chastain and a second by Commissioner Kelton. The Court voted 5-0 to approve. An Affidavit, with the Report attached, was signed, and prepared for publication, according to Section 114.026 of the Texas Local Government Code. (Exhibit #2)

After discussion, Commissioner Traweek moved that the Court approve and expenditure up to \$2,500.00, from the "Opioid Funds" to purchase and install a carport for the Veterans Administration van. Commissioner Chastain seconded the motion, and the Court voted 5-0 to approve.
