After undergoing two major surgeries in 2025, I have decided to not seek re-election for the coming term, and to retire from my position as Brown County Treasurer effective midnight, December 31, 2025.

I would like to thank the citizens of Brown County, past and present elected and appointed officials, and all my co-workers of Brown County for their trust and support during my years of service, nine years as Assistant County Treasurer and twenty years as Brown County Treasurer.

I view my twenty-nine years of service to Brown County with great pride; my twenty years as the Brown County Treasurer makes me the longest-serving Treasurer in the history of Brown County. I believe that I am also the first Republican to hold this office in Brown County.

As I prepare myself to leave the office I have held for two decades, I am proud to report the investments I have made during my tenure have earned over \$4.3 million dollars for the taxpayers of Brown County. In addition to this revenue, I have implemented many innovations to the procedures employed by the Treasurer's Office.

As a reminder, despite my letter of retirement, by statute, I will continue to hold the authority and privileges of the position of County Treasurer until a replacement is sworn in after my retirement date.
