He addressed the Court, thanking those who have helped him over the years and to the voters of Brown County Precinct #4 for placing their trust in him. Acting Judge Munson thanked him, on behalf of the County, for his dedicated service to Brown County. Commissioner Chastain moved that the Court accept the

resignation of Mike Isbell, Constable Precinct #4. Commissioner Traweck seconded the motion, and the Court voted 4-0 to approve. ([Exhibit #2](#))

- b. Consideration and possible approval to renew contract with Hilltop Securities. Presented by County Auditor.**
