



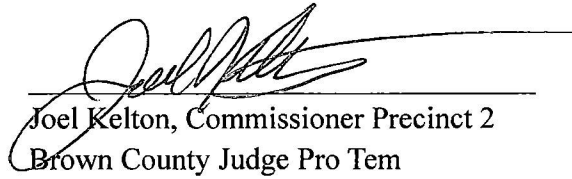

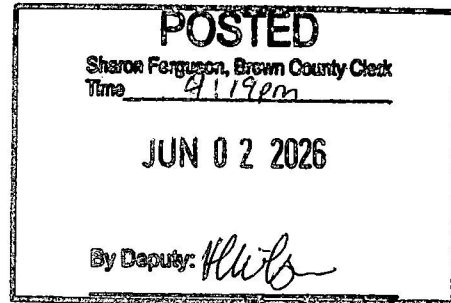

Commissioner Chastain moved that the Court approve the Canvass Report for the Primary Runoff Election held May 26, 2026, as presented by Elections Administrator Brenda Arp. Commissioner Reid seconded the motion, and the Court voted 3-0 to approve. (Exhibit #7)

- c. Consideration and possible action to appoint Tom Munson as Acting County Judge pursuant to Local Government Code Section 26.017. Presented by Joel Kelton, County Judge Pro-Tem.**

Commissioner Chastain moved the Court to enter an Order Appointing Tom Munson as Acting County Judge of Brown County, Texas effective June 8, 2026. Commissioner Reid seconded the motion, and the Court voted 3-0 to approve. (Exhibit #8)

Mike Smith, Brown County District Judge, swore Acting County Judge Tom Munson into office. Mr. Munson signed a Statement of Elected/Appointed Official, Oath Of Office, and his bond. At 9:20 a.m. Judge Munson stepped into his new position and took charge of the Court. (Exhibit #9)
